Central Asia Political Map





WHAT TO VISIT IN UZBEKISTAN ?



Shastri Monument, Tashkent

For most of the residents of Tashkent Shastri is a city landmark, however for any Indian, Shastri is a great figure belonging to the same level of political figures as Mahatma Gandhi and Javaharlal Nehru. Today there is a monument in the central part of the city on the crossroad dedicated to the person who had greatly contributed to the development of India and who had left a track in the history of not only India, but also Tashkent.

Amir Timur Museum

Museum of the History of Timurids (also called Amir Timur Museum) was established in Tashkent in 2006. Today it is an important landmark ...



Lake Charvak

Lake Charvak, meaning 'four gardens' in Persian, is a water reservoir located in the Bostanli District of Tashkent, Uzbekistan. The reservoir gets the maximum water from Oskem, Koks, and Chatkal rivers confluence in the Tian Shan mountains.

It is a famous resort in Tashkent and attracts many tourists who come to enjoy the beautiful view of the reservoir. You can enjoy paragliding here and stay at any one of the numerous hotels, tapchans, houses, and dachas available nearby and it is one of the must visit places in Uzbekistan. This lake was also an archaeological site before the reservoir was filled up and all the sites submerged.

Independence Square, Tashkent

Independence Square is located in the center of Tashkent city. It is a favorite resting place for the Tashkent residents. The fact that the most beautiful fountains of the city are located in the square contributed considerably to it.

Opera and Ballet Grand Academic Theatre

The Opera and Ballet Theatre is one of the most interesting tourist attractions in Tashkent. The theatre is located in the very heart of the city, next to the Central Department Store and Tashkent's oldest hotel, in a historical building with an original design.



CHORSU BAZAAR, TASHKENT, UZBEKISTAN

Bazaar is the heart of every oriental city, the center of public life, breadwinner of the whole city. Since the dawn of time bazaars appeared on the intersections of trade roads, on big squares of cities. They played role of main places of the city, where merchants, traders and common people gathered to discuss important news, to know prices, to have a rest in cozy choykhana (Uzbek café) eating pilaf and drinking green tea. Also bazaars were the places of main entertaining events of the city – theatrical performances.



SAMARKAND

Samarkand is a city in Uzbekistan known for its mosques and mausoleums. It's on the Silk Road, the ancient trade route linking China to the Mediterranean. Prominent landmarks include the Registan, a plaza bordered by 3 ornate, majolica-covered madrasahs dating to the 15th and 17th centuries, and Gur-e-Amir, the towering tomb of Timur (Tamerlane), founder of the Timurid Empire.





ABOUT SAMARKAND

- ▶ One of the main reasons to visit Samarkand Uzbekistan is to marvel at the stunning Islamic architecture of its mosques and mausoleums. Poets and historians described the city as “The Pearl of the Eastern Muslim World”.
- ▶ **VISIT GUR-E-AMIR MAUSOLEUM OR THE MAUSOLEUM OF AMIR TIMUR** Gur-e-Amir, meaning “Tomb of the King” in Persian, is a beautiful architectural complex with a ribbed turquoise dome.
- ▶ **EXPLORE THE REGISTAN** The Registan is about 10 minutes walking from Gur-e-Amir. This central square THE most iconic sight of Samarkand and Uzbekistan.
- ▶ **VISIT THE HISTORIC BIBI KHANYM MOSQUE** The Bibi Khanym Mosque is one of the most important monuments of Samarkand. It was named after the wife of Timur the Great.



- Dress modestly, covering arms and legs, when entering a holy site.
- Use the whole hand and arm when beckoning to an Uzbek.

▶ DON'T

- Walk in front of people during their prayers. It invalidates their prayer.
- Don't use the left hand to pass things to a Muslim. The left hand is considered unclean.
- Point a finger at an Uzbek. Finger-pointing is demeaning.
- Beckon an Uzbek by curling your index finger. This is considered insulting since only animals are called in this manner.
- Bring search dogs into a mosque or holy place. Dogs are unclean animals in Islam and their presence renders prayer invalid.



The Baku Ateshgah, often called the "Fire Temple of Baku" is a castle-like religious temple in Surakhani, a suburb in Baku, Azerbaijan. Based on Persian and Indian inscriptions, the temple was used as a Hindu and Zoroastrian place of worship. "Atash" (is the Persian word for fire)

YAN



Yanar Dag is a natural gas fire which blazes continuously on a hillside on the Absheron Peninsula. Flames jet into the air 3 metres (9.8 ft) from a thin, porous sandstone layer.

► Day 1: Phnom Penh Arrival - City Tour

Arrival at Phnom Penh Airport, you will be met and transfer to your select hotel. And discover the Phnom Penh City, visit WAT PHNOM PAGODA, an ancient pagoda stand up on the hill, Independence Monument commemorates the end of Cambodia's ruled by France in 1953, WAT UNALOM PAGODA, the oldest Buddhist foundation in the city, probably predating the abandonment of the capital at Angkor in 15th century. The founding date is variously cited as 1422 and 1443. This wat is the home to the Buddhist patriarch and then we walk along the riverfront, the confluence of the Tonle Sap, Mekong and Bassac Rivers for taking fresh air.



GABALA CITY TOUR

Gabala is considered a popular tourist destination due to the combination of a very good spring climate, mountainous landscape, and diverse fauna. Many sizable world hotel chains have a presence in the city. Natural climatic conditions of the region create opportunities for the development of both summer and winter tourism in the region.

- **“Nohurgol” Lake** : The lake is surrounded by a forest, you can walk around the lake. Here you can relax, sail boat on the lake.
- **Tufandag Summer-Winter Complex:** Longest teleferic of the world - Whether for skiing, or just for memorable summer views of the Caucasus scenery behind Gabala, jump aboard the Tufandag network of four cable cars. The complex serves up to 3,000 people a day.
- **Gabala Shooting club** : Shooting experience.
- **Chukhur Gabala:** Chukhur Gabala is the archeological site of remains of historic Gabala. The remains of medieval water pipe and sewer system have still survived.
- **Gabaland:** Gabaland is the Azerbaijan's number one short break destination and Gabala's greatest escape! The Gabaland offers the leading theme park in a Caucasus region with amazing rides and endless family fun and Gabala Resort fantastical hotel.



GOBUSTAN TOUR – UNESCO SITE

Gobustan is very rich in archaeological monuments. The reserve has more than 6,000 rock engravings dating back between 5,000–40,000 years. The site also features the remains of inhabited caves, settlements and burials, all reflecting an intensive human use by the inhabitants of the area during the wet period that followed the last Ice Age.

Most of the rock engravings depict primitive men, animals, battle-pieces, ritual dances, bullfights, boats with armed oarsmen, warriors with lances in their hands, camel caravans, pictures of sun and stars.

Gobustan was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site considered to be of "outstanding universal value" for the quality and density of its rock art engravings, for the substantial evidence the collection of rock art images presents for hunting, fauna, flora and lifestyles in pre-historic times.
